History/Description:

Carl Landegger was the President and CEO of Parsons and Whittemore (P&W) of New York. Parsons and Whittemore was the majority owner of the Prince Albert Pulp Mill, which started operations in 1968.

P&W sold the mill to their minority partner (Government of Saskatchewan) in 1980. The mill was sold to Weyerhaeuser in 1987. Weyerhaeuser closed the mill in April 2006 then transferred their assets to a subsidiary Domtar in August 2006. Domtar has applied for a demolition permit.

The mill buildings are located on the north side of the Saskatchewan River, 10 kms east of the Diefenbaker Bridge, Prince Albert.
