History/Description:

Mattes Avenue in Prince Albert is the equivalent of 17th Avenue east, just south of the Saskatchewan River.

Frank Mattes was the sawmill manager for the Winton Brothers when they invested in the forest industry in the Prince Albert area. The first mill they purchased was located where the present Mattes Avenue meets the North Saskatchewan River. The Winton Brothers purchased it from Telford.

Their P.A. mill was eventually the largest complete mill in the province. Mattes eventually moved to Big River when the Wintons bought that facility.
