History/Description:

A huge collection of elms, northeast of Hudson Bay.

This is a low area at the junction of the Smoking Tent creek and the Red Deer river, and is regularly flooded at spring break-up when the ice jams at the junction.

This good and moist site has enable the growth of luxuriant ferns up to 6' tall, (but also stinging nettles).

The elms here are natural, and are among the largest in the province.
