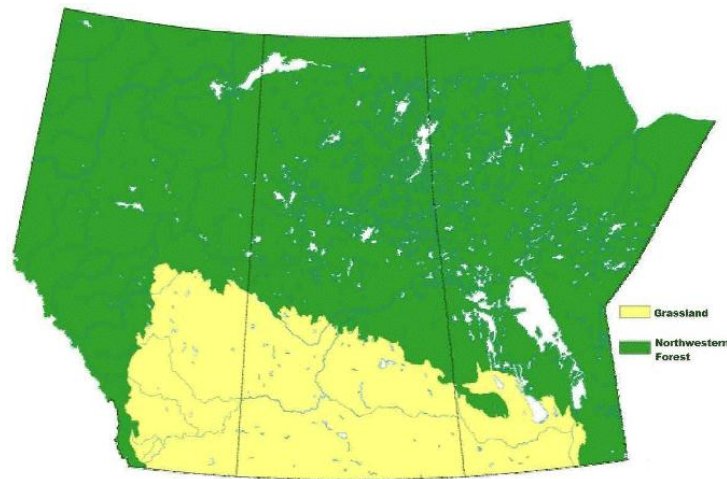


Saskatchewan's Boreal Forest



- In Saskatchewan our Boreal Forest is described by what it has in it-- air, water, land, living things, and humans.
- **Ecozones** tells us about the kind of land it has such as hills, lowlands, bogs. In Saskatchewan we have four ecozones which are:
 1. Taiga Shield---has lots of lakes and little trees
 2. Boreal Shield---has forests and shield with Black Spruce and Jack Pine trees and fish like lake trout and grayling
 3. Boreal Plain---has gently rolling hills, with warm water fish such as northern pike, walleye, whitefish
 4. Prairie---has grassland, gently rolling hills, and farming
